ORDINANCE NO. SP-**1478**, S-2005

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE BARANGAY MALAYA TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION (BM TODA) TO OPERATE (10) MOTORIZED TRICYCLES FOR HIRE PLYING WITHIN THE DESIGNATED ROUTES IN BARANGAY MALAYA, DISTRICT IV, THIS CITY.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government considers the significance of an efficient and inexpensive transportation facility as a basic necessity which should always be made available to the riding public, particularly in the interior areas of the city that would bring them towards the main thoroughfares within the limits of its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, there exist no other TODAs operating within Barangay Malaya that could service its own constituents at present, although Barangay Sikatuna Village TODA caters to some portion of Barangay Malaya it is not enough to fully service the entire barangay;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Malaya TODA vehemently sought the approval of the Tricycle Franchising Board on their request to establish a TODA in their barangay to provide livelihood opportunities to its residents;

WHEREAS, the applicant is duly registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission with Company Registration No. CN200412317;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of Barangay Malaya has authorized the operation of applicant TODA to service within the designated routes in the said barangay, and has endorsed the same to all offices and departments concerned for further approval and has appropriate action through Resolution No. 057, S-2004;

WHEREAS, members of the Tricycle Franchising Board have conducted an ocular inspection of January 25, 2005 on the proposed route of operation of the applicant TODA;

WHEREAS, the petition for accreditation of Barangay Malaya has been approved by the members of the Tricycle Franchising Board on its special Board Meeting on February 2, 2005 and was confirmed on its 146th Public Hearing on February 3, 2005 at the Carlos Albert Hall, Quezon City.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. That the Barangay Malaya TODA is hereby granted authority to operate ten (10) motorized tricycles for hire within the designated routes in Barangay Malaya, District IV, this City, provided:

1. The route of operation, color scheme and body numbering shall be subject to approval by the Tricycle Franchising Board (TFB) and the Tricycle Regulation Unit (TRU), and;
2. The designated tricycle terminal shall be subject to inspection and approval by the Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS).


SECTION 2. The individual applicants for franchise should be filed and approved by the Tricycle Franchising Board (TFB) upon compliance of existing rules and regulations.


SECTION 3. This grant of authority shall be subject to all existing laws, rules and regulations for tricycle service, violation of which shall cause the revocation or suspension of said authority.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediate upon approval.




