ORDINANCE NO. SP- **2071** , S-2011

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING TOP TEN (10) GRADUATES OF ALL PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN QUEZON CITY, AS REGULAR SCHOLARS OF SCHOLARSHIP AND YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (SYDP).

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State to establish and maintain a system of scholarship grants, student loan programs, subsidies and other incentives which shall be available to deserving students in both private and public schools especially to the underprivileged;

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City Government to provide scholarship grants to intelligent, gifted and deserving poor and underprivileged students;

WHEREAS, to enhance the educational opportunities for the City's poor constituents, especially for post-secondary education, there must be established and maintained a system that will provide scholarships for the most number of students given a limited budget.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There shall be selected annually from the graduating classes of all public high schools throughout Quezon City, poor but deserving students to be known as SYDP Scholars.

SECTION 2. It is hereby mandated that the first top ten (10) of the graduating classes of all public high schools in Quezon City shall automatically be qualified as scholars of Scholarship and Youth Development Program (SYDP), regardless if he/she is already a scholar of other institution or schools.


SECTION 3. The Scholarship criteria shall be the following:

- a. The prospective scholars shall be bonafide resident of Quezon City while pursuing his/her studies;
- b. He/she must be in good health and good moral character; and
- c. He/she must be a graduate of any public schools in Quezon City.


SECTION 4. This program shall be automatically be provided with adequate funding every year.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


