

Ordinance No. NC - 149, S-90

ORDINANCE

TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF THE CITY SWIMMING POOL AT BERNARDO PARK AND PRESCRIBING FEES THEREFOR.

Introduced by Councilors Alberto M. Galarpe and Wilma Amoranto-Sarino.

Co-Introduced by Councilors Guillermo C. Altuna, and Roberto A. Miguel.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. The swimming pool at Bernardo Park shall be managed and operated by the Quezon City Youth and Sports Development Office under the Office of the Vice Mayor.

SECTION 2. The Quezon City Youth and Sports Development Office is hereby authorized to organize or establish a Quezon City Swimming Association thru membership thereof. Members of the organized QCSA can avail of the use of the swimming pool at a token fee of Five Pesos (P5.00), provided that membership fee shall be paid as follows:

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP FEE

Adult	- - - - -	P50.00
Minor	- - - - -	20.00

A registry book shall be kept by the Youth and Sports Development Office containing the names, addresses and ages of the members. Said book shall be available for inspection by the City Authorities at any time during regular office hours.

SECTION 3. Other than for the use of its members, the swimming pool may also be used by non-members at a prescribed rate of Ten Pesos (P10.00) per person.

SECTION 4. The Mayor or the Vice Mayor may authorize the exclusive use of the swimming pool either for a fee or free of charge for special occasion or for any special events, participated in by both members and non-members of the QCSA, like swimming competition. For special occasions or events, Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (P250.00) per day may be charged.

SECTION 5. The swimming pool shall be open to the members and the public from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. only - Monday thru Sunday except on days for repair and Friday which will be reserved for water replacement, treatment and cleanliness maintenance of the pool.

SECTION 6. Minors below six (6) years old shall not be allowed within the pool unless accompanied by a parent/guardian or responsible relative. (For the particular purpose of this ordinance adult shall mean person eighteen (18) years of age or above while minor shall mean below eighteen (18) years of age).

SECTION 7. The City Treasurer shall assign a collector who shall collect all fees before the use of the swimming pool. The collector shall be at the entrance of said swimming pool 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. every-day except for days where said pool is not available as cited above. All fees collected therefrom shall form part of the General Fund of the City.

SECTION 8. Ordinance No. 5219, S-62 and Ordinance No. 5450, S-63 previously giving authority to the Y's Mens Club of Quezon City to manage and operate said pool during Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays are hereby repealed. Other revenue ordinances or parts thereof which are inconsistent herewith are hereby modified and/or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 9. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
