ORDINANCE

APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED

THOUSAND PESOS (\$\frac{1}{2}\$,500,000.00) FOR THE PURCHASE OF SCIENTIFIC

APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT TO BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE DIFFERENT

SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, significantly the introduction and use of scientific apparatus and equipment in the Quezon City Secondary Schools is in the right direction to a higher level of education we can impart to our students; and

whereas, the aforementioned scientific apparatus and equipment will be among the instructional devices intended for the first time to be made available to students of secondary schools in Quezon City as embodied under the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) Order No. 88-S-1988;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in

Sec. 1.- There is hereby appropriated the sum of Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P3,500,000.00) from any available funds in the City Treasury for the purchase of the scientific apparatus and equipment as follows:

- 1. HUMAN TORZO (Transistorized Circulatory System)
 H-23 W. 9 T. 4", Base houses all control system
 that stimulate the veins, heart and arteries
 function, with teachers manual.
- FIRE FALLING APPARATUS Digital transistorized release system start/stop electronic timer with mechanical electronic base censor; with teachers manual.
- 3. SOUTH POLE ELECTRON-MAGNETIC FORCE GENERATING APPARATUS with teachers manual.
- 4. INTEGRATED WEATHER MONITORING SYSTEM APPARATUS, Electronic transmitter and receiver, analog, 100 kph cap. with wall thermometer, humidity temperature indicators, rain gauge and climate map of the Philippines with teachers manual.
- 5. SCIENCE INQUIRY SYSTEM (Properties of Light) with teachers manual.

Sec. 2 - The scientific apparatus and equipment enumerated and described under Section One hereof shall be distributed to the different Secondary Schools in Quezon City.
