ORDINANCE

CREATING THE POSITION OF LEGISLATIVE LIAISON OFFICER, PROVIDING FOR HIS COMPENSATION, POWERS AND DUTIES AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Creation of the Position of Legislative Liaison Officer. - There is hereby created one (1) position of Legislative Liaison Officer under the supervision and control of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Quezon City.

SECTION 2. Appointment and Compensation. - Subject to Civil Service Law and Rules, the Legislative Liaison Officer shall be appointed by the City Mayor and confirmed by the City Council. He shall receive a salary, allowances and other emoluments equivalent to those being received by Assistant Department Heads of the City Government.

SECTION 3. Powers and Duties. - The Legislative Liaison Officer shall perform the following duties and functions:

- a. Provides liaison services for the City Council, particularly with the Department of Local Government, the Congress of the Philippines, the national and local bureaucracies and non-governmental organizations;
- b. Perform such other duties and functions as may be directed by the City Council.

SECTION 4. Appropriation. - There is hereby appropriated annually in the City Treasury of Quezon City, the amount of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED AND TWENTY PESOS (P155,420.00) to cover the payment of the salary, allowances and other expenses of the Legislative Liaison Officer.

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NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:
