THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED EIGHT PESOS AND SEVENTY CENTAVOS (\$\P\$455,408.70) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF THE QUEZON CITY DRUG TREATMENT AND REHABILITATION CENTER, INCLUDING THE EXPENSES OF THE TASK
FORCE-QCDTRC CREATED UNDER EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 15
OF THE CITY MAYOR.

WHEREAS, by virtue of Ordinance No. NC-105, S-89 (Special Foundation Tax) the City was able to generate a revenue in the total sum of Two Million Five Hundred Four Thousand Four Hundred Sixty Three Pesos and Sixty Two Centavos (\$\partial 2,504,463.62);

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. NC-114, S-89 allowed the Quezon City Drug Treatment and Rehabilitation Center to use Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (₱500,000.00) out of this Special Foundation Tax for its necessary expenses;

WHEREAS, after disbursements from this fund were made in accordance with the purpose provided for by ordinances there still remains a balance in the amount of Four Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand Four Hundred Eight Pesos and Seventy Centavos (\$\frac{12}{2}\$455,408.70);

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. The amount of Four Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand Four Hundred Eight Pesos and Seventy Centavos (\$455,408.70) representing the remaining balance in the fund established under Ordinance No. 105, S-89 (Special Foundation Tax) is hereby appropriated for the expenses necessary for the construction and operation of the Quezon City Drug Treatment and Rehabilitation Center, including those of Task Force-QCDTRC created under Executive Order No. 15 of the City Mayor.
