ORDINANCE

APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF NINE MILLION PESOS (P9,000,000.00) OUT OF ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY TREASURY AS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE BY WAY OF PROVIDING CASH LOANS TO THE FIRE VICTIM FAMILIES OF BARANGAY ESCOPA II AND BARANGAY ESCOPA IV IN THE 3RD DISTRICT OF QUEZON CITY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, fire recently destroyed the houses of the residents of Barangay Escopa II and Barangay Escopa IV in the 3rd District of Quezon City, forcing said fire victims to live in makeshift shelters where they are exposed to the elements;

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to extend financial assistance to the fire victim families in said barangays in order to enable them to rebuild their houses and mitigate the effects of said conflagration;

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the City Council as provided under Section 177(i) of the Local Government Code, to make suitable provisions to protect the public from conflagration and to prevent and mitigate the effects of famine, floods, storms and other public calamities, and provide relief to victims thereof;

WHEREAS, in compliance with the aforesaid responsibility of the City Council, it was deemed necessary to extend financial assistance to said fire victim families by way of providing, and making available to them, cash loans for the reconstruction of their houses, in line with the housing program of the Quezon City Government;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any available funds of the City Treasury the amount of NINE MILLION PESOS (P9,000,000.00) as financial assistance which shall be made available as cash loans to the fire victim families of Barangay Escopa II and Barangay Escopa IV in the 3rd District of Quezon City for the reconstruction of their houses which were razed by fire.

Section 2. The City Mayor and the City Treasury of Quezon City are hereby authorized to disburse the funds appropriated under Section 1 hereof as cash loans to the said fire victim families in said barangays.

Section 3. The City Mayor shall issue the necessary guidelines for the implementation of this Ordinance which shall set forth, among others, the amount which shall be made available to each fire victim family and the manner of repayment thereof.

Section 4. The cash loans which each fire victim family shall receive under this Ordinance shall be tied up with, and shall be considered as advance loan, under the Unified Lending Program of the National Home Mortgage Finance Corporation. The said loan shall be paid by the fire victim families out of the loan which may later be made available to them by the National Home Mortgage Finance Corporation under its Unified Home Lending Program, less whatever amount said families have already paid to Quezon City.

Section 5. The City Mayor shall initiate and undertake the necessary financial arrangement with the National Home Mortgage Finance Corporation and the fire victim families for the purpose provided in Section 3 hereof.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
