

ORDINANCE

PROVIDING THAT THE INTERNAL BUDGET ALLOTTED FOR THE CITY COUNCIL BE SUB-ALLOTTED FOR EACH AND EVERY INDIVIDUAL MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL INCLUDING THE QUALIFIED REPRESENTATIVES THEREOF AND GIVING THEM EXCLUSIVE ADMINISTRATION, SUPERVISION AND CONTROL OVER THE SAME.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. SP-39, S-92 otherwise known as Annual Budget of the Quezon City Government for Calendar Year of 1993 allotted among others, Internal Budget for the City Council;

WHEREAS, the foregoing allotment should and must be equally sub-allotted for each and every individual member of the City Council including the qualified representatives in accordance with the mandate of the said Ordinance No. SP-39 Series of 1992;

WHEREAS, each and every individual member of the City Council including that of qualified representatives shall have direct administration management, supervision and control over the said sub-allotment of the Internal Budget of the City Council for its proper, legitimate and equitable disposition;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The Internal Budget allotted for the City Council shall be sub-allotted for each and every individual member thereof including the qualified representatives but excluding the Office of the Vice Mayor, subject to existing ordinances and resolutions and such implementing rules and regulations which the City Council may provide from time to time.

SECTION 2. The said sub-allotment shall have the corresponding sub-allotment advice number for each and every individual member of the City Council including the qualified representatives the

SECTION 3. Each and every individual member of the City Council including the qualified representatives thereof shall be in-charge exclusively and solely for the said sub-allotment as well as supervision over the accounting and financial operation thereof.

SECTION 4. All payrolls, vouchers, cash advances, purchase orders, allotments, and other necessary documentation of expenditures pertaining to the aforesaid sub-allotment shall be recommended for approval by the individual member of the City Council concerned including the qualified representative.

SECTION 5. Copy of this Ordinance with specimen signatures of each and individual member of the City Council including qualified representatives thereof, be furnished the Office of the City Mayor, City Treasurer, City Auditor, City Budget Officer and other different offices concerned for their information guidance and compliance.

SECTION 6. The Internal Accounts Committee created by Resolution No. NC-14, S-88, as modified is hereby abolished and abrogated, and all other ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are considered repealed and/or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
