/Ordinance No. SP-53, S-93:

ORDINANCE

REQUIRING THE ACCREDITED AUTHORIZED CONTRACTOR TO POST INFORMATION OF ALL PUBLIC WORKS AND INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS WITHIN THE CITY, INCLUDING FUNDS ALLOCATED THERETO; AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, there is a general perception among our constituents of the prevalence of graft and corruption in the government of bureaucracy, specifically as regards the implementation of public works and infrastructure projects;

WHEREAS, there is a need for transparency and full disclosure of the handling of government funds allocated for public works and infrastructure projects;

WHEREAS, the people has the right to know where and how their taxes are spent;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Accredited contracting parties shall post information of all public works and infrastructure projects within the City at the expense of the contractor undertaking the project fifteen (15) days after the finalization of the contracts therefor which shall include the following;

1. Name of project;
2. Name of the contracting company;
3. Total amount of funds allocated therefor and the estimated cost of the project;
4. The performance time allotted thereto.

The size of the sign shall be 4ft by 8ft for projects costing over a Million; and 4ft by 4ft for projects costing less than a Million; and the materials and scope of work shall be readily presented upon inquiry of any person.

SECTION 2. A fine of Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) and/or imprisonment of not more than one (1) year shall be imposed as penalty for failure to comply therewith.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
