ORDINANCE

CHANGING THE NAME OF PASONG TAMO HIGH SCHOOL INTO SAUYO HIGH SCHOOL (NIA Village) BARANGAY SAUYO, NOVALICHES, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, in order to avoid confusion as to which barangay has the jurisdiction over the Pasong Tamo High School and to correct a misnomer, there is a need to change the name of Pasong Tamo High School into Sauyo High School (NIA Village) which is located at Barangay Sauyo and not in Barangay Pasong Tamo where it is often times mistaken to be located;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of Barangay Sauyo adopted Resolution No. 032-92, requesting the Quezon City Council to change the name of Pasong Tamo High School into Sauyo High School (NIA Village);

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The name of Pasong Tamo High School located at 1st Laguna Street, Barangay Sauyo, Novaliches, Quezon City is hereby change into Sauyo High School (NIA Village).

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect for School Year 1993.
