AN ORDINANCE GRANTING AMNESTY TO DELINQUENT TRAFFIC VIOLATORS IN QUEZEN CITY APPREMENDED FOR THE MONTHS OF OCTOBER TO DECEMBER 1995 BY CONDONING THE FIVE PERCENT (5%) PENALTY PER DAY

WHEREAS Ordinance No. SP-1444, S-2004, provides for the creation of the Traffic Management Code of Quezon City, implementing the issuance of the Ordinance Violation Receipts (OVR) to traffic violation offenders and the settling up of OVR Redemption Center,

WHEREAS, in line with the celebration of the First Year Anniversary of the implementation of the Traffic Management Code of Quezon City, the Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS) intends to highlight the occusion by giving unnesty to traffic violators for the months of October to December 2005:

W. FE. REAS, the Local Government Code clearly provides under Section 192, that

"Local government units may, through ordinances duly approved, grant tax exemptions, in others or reliefs under such terms and conditions at the province of the conditions are they may deem necessary."

WHEREAS, the grant of amnesty will be beneficial to drivers of this City who were traffic violators apprehended on the aforementioned period only;

WHEREAS, this amnesty will encourage delinquent traffic violators of the city to sottle unar obligature and generally acre revenues for the City government that will be needed in the delivery of basic services for the benefit of the residents of Quezon City;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION

SECTION 1. There is hereby granted a one hundred percent (100%) relief on the five percent (5%) penalty per day to all delinquent traffic violators in Quezon City who were apprehended for the months of October to December 2005 and shall only require payment of the basic fine to their corresponding violations;

SECTION 2. The amnesty granted herein maybe availed of only from November 6 to December 29, 2006.

SECTION 3. The Department of Public Order and Safety (DFCS) and the City Treasurer shall jointly promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for the implementation of this Ordeance.

SECTION 4. All ordinances, resolutions, orders, issuances thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
