(PR2007-147)

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE LOGISTICS POLICY GUIDELINES FORMULATED BY THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG) ORGANIZED BY THE QUEZON CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT (QCHD) IN PURSUANT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (DOH) ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 158, FOCUSING ON CONTRACEPTIVE SELF RELIANCE (CSR).

WHEREAS, it is a state policy to ensure the protection and preservation of its population and to adopt relevant measures for the welfare of its constituency;

WHEREAS, likewise, the City government is mandated under the Local Government Code of 1991 to provide Family Planning services and to ensure contraceptive availability in the community;

WHEREAS, as per Administrative Order No. 158 issued by the Department Of Health (DOH), which clearly provides for the orderly transition from externally donated contraceptive to domestically provided commodities for family planning, prompted the formulation of the Logistics Policy Guidelines by the Technical Working Group (TWG) duly organized by the Q.C. Health Department;


WHEREAS, it is necessary to adopt the aforesaid policy guidelines so as to ensure that the actual levels of contraceptive supplies in the community are not disrupted during the phase out period;

WHEREAS, further, it is imperative to similarly adopt the same in order for the current Contraceptive Prevalence Rate (CPR) not to decline, that is in line with the goal of eliminating the unmet need in Family Planning by maintaining the quarterly delivery schedule of such supplies to health centers.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

Section 1. There is hereby adopted the Logistics Policy Guidelines formulated by the Technical Working Group (TWG) organized by the Quezon City Health Department (QCHD) in pursuant with the Department of Health (DOH) Administrative Order No. 158 focusing on contraceptive self reliance.




Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.




