ORDINANCE NO. SP **1812** S-2007
(PO2007-86)

AN ORDINANCE ACCREDITING FORTY-NINE (49) NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS (NGOs) AND PEOPLE'S ORGANIZATIONS (POs), PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991 AND ITS IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS, IN RELATION WITH DILG MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2007-81.

WHEREAS, Section 34 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", provides that the Local Government Units shall promote the establishment and operations of people's and non-governmental organizations to become partners in the pursuit of local autonomy;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991, particularly Article 64 of its Implementing Rules and Regulations provides, among others, that the local sanggunian concerned shall accredit non-governmental and people's organizations subject to the criteria and procedures provided therein for membership in the local special bodies;

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. SP-23, S-92 the NGO and PO Accreditation Committee was created to process applications for accreditation of non-governmental and people's organization;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations and DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2007-81, dated July 17, 2007, a call for accreditation was made by the Quezon City Council through the NGO and PO Accreditation Committee;

WHEREAS, these Forty - Nine (49) Non - Governmental Organizations and People's Organizations applied for accreditation with the Quezon City Council thru the Community Relations Office;

WHEREAS, the applications of the said organizations were processed and considered by the NGO and PO Accreditation Committee and favorably recommended their accreditation by the Quezon City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

Section 1. There are hereby accredited Forty-Nine (49) Non - Governmental Organizations (NGOs) and People's Organizations (POs), pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, in relation with DILG Circular No. 2007-81, the official list of which is hereto attached and made an integral part of this Ordinance.



The herein accredited organizations shall, within 30 days, inform the Quezon City Council, through the Office of the City Council Secretary, copy furnished the Community Relations Office, of any major change/s in their organizations, particularly with respect to their officers and office addresses.


