ORDINANCE NO. SP-1885S-2008

*AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A PROVISIONAL FARE ROLL BACK  
IN ALL TRICYCLE FOR HIRE IN QUEZON CITY.*

*Introduced by Councilors ALLAN BUTCH T. FRANCISCO, FRANZ S. PUMAREN, ANTONIO E. INTON, JR., JESUS MANUEL C. SUNTAY, BERNADETTE HERRERA-DY, DOROTHY A. DELARMENTE, VICTOR V. FERRER, JR. RICARDO T. *WHEREAS, world oil prices continue to plunge substantially from a record high of \$140/barrel in July, 2008 to \$45.72/barrel to date;*

*WHEREAS, this trend in the international market has prompted oil companies, namely Shell, Petron, Chevron, PTT Philippines, Total, Jetti, City Oil and Rephil to implement more frequent price rollbacks;*

*WHEREAS, with this favorable change of global scenario, the justifications then existent which led to the passage of the ordinance granting increases are already a thing in the past. Correspondingly, the commuting public must enjoy the benefit from there for the government was not naïve with the demands of the operators of the public utility vehicles during the time of their crisis;*

*WHEREAS, it has been announced in the public that all operators of public utility vehicles governed by Land Transportation Franchising Regularity Board (LTFRB) will reduce their present fare matrix;*

WHEREAS, there is a strong pressure from the riding public of tricycles for hire that operators and drivers of the same must impose a reasonable fare roll back amending City Ordinance No. SP-1850, S2008, "AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A FARE INCREASE FOR ALL TRICYCLE FOR HIRE IN QUEZON CITY FROM SIX PESOS (P6.00) TO SEVEN PESOS AND FIFTY CENTAVOS (P7.50) PER PERSON IN REGULAR TRIPS AND FOR SPECIAL TRIPS FROM TWELVE PESOS (P12.00) TO FIFTEEN PESOS (P15.00) AND AN ADDITIONAL OF ONE PESO (P1.00) FOR EVERY KILOMETER IN EXCESS THEREOF FOR BOTH REGULAR AND SPECIAL TRIPS," to keep pace with the dip of the oil prices;

WHEREAS, operators and drivers of the tricycles for hire are cognizant of the need of this demand and have in fact expressed their full support and cooperation for the accomplishment of the purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The Tricycles Fare in Quezon City is hereby reduced in accordance with the following schedule:

A. General Riding Public (those who are not considered as Senior Citizens, Disabled and Students)

Regular Trips – Seven Pesos (P7.00) for the first kilometer plus Fifty Centavos (0.50) for every kilometer in excess thereof;

Special Trips – Fourteen Pesos (P14.00) for the first kilometer plus Fifty Centavos (0.50) for every kilometer in excess thereof;

B. Senior Citizen, Disabled Persons and Student Fare – Twenty Percent (20%) discount, to wit:

Regular Trips – Five Pesos and Sixty Centavos (P5.60) for the first kilometer and Forty Centavos (0.40) for every kilometer in excess thereof;

Special Trips – Eleven Pesos and Twenty Centavos (P11.20) for the first kilometer and Forty Centavos (0.40) for every kilometer in excess thereof.


SECTION 2. Any Ordinance or provision thereof, rules, regulations, executives order and other similar issuances not consistent with the provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 3. The above fare rates are subject to modifications upon recommendation by the Committee on Transportation and Communication.


SECTION 4. Any person found violating the provision of this ordinance shall be penalized by a fine of Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) or imprisonment of Six (6) Months or both at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.




