ORDINANCE NO. SP-1888S-2009

**AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FOR THE PAYMENT OF BUSINESS TAXES AND FEES FROM JANUARY 20, 2009 TO FEBRUARY 2, 2009.**

*WHEREAS, in view of the limitations of the existing manpower and facilities of the City Treasury to accommodate the large number of taxpayers paying their business taxes and fees for year 2009, the first quarter payment period from January 1 to 20, 2009 is deemed insufficient,*

WHEREAS, in the interest of the tax-paying public of Quezon City, the deadline for payments should be extended to at least ten (10) days to accommodate business tax payments without penalty;

WHEREAS, in consideration of the limitation of the present collection system to service the voluminous number of taxpayer, the City may provide for an extended grace period of time to accept payments without penalty, but likewise, conform within the limits set by existing laws and ordinances.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

Section 1. Coverage - All annual quarterly business taxes and fees due and payable to the Quezon City Government for 2009 which is due to be paid on or before January 20, 2009 can be paid not later than February 2, 2009, without any penalty, surcharge or interest.


Section 2. Penalty and Interest - All business taxes and fees due for the current period shall however, be subject to twenty-five percent (25%) penalty and monthly interest of two percent (2%) if not paid on or before February 2, 2009.

Section 3. Repealing Clause - Any provision of law, executive order or other rules and regulations inconsistent with the provision of this ordinance is hereby repealed amended or modified accordingly.


Section 4. Effectivity - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.


