NO ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF BREAST CARE CENTER IN QUEZON CITY, APPROPRIATING WORLDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 17, (a) of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that, local government units shall endeavor to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the unties and functions currently vested upon them. They shall also discharge the functions and responsibilities of national agencies and offices devolved to them pursuant to this Code. Local Government Units shall likewise exercise such other and discharge such other functions responsibilities as one necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provision of the basic services and fucilities herein:

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. SP-4008. S-2007 on December 10, 2007 and Resolution No. SP-3349. S-2006, expressing support for the celebration of Breast Cancer Awareness Month observed every month of October:

WHEREAS, taking into consideration the maternal functions of women it shall be the responsibility of the City tovernment to provide facilities and services that will enhance their welfare and enable them to fully contribute their potential in service to the society:

WHEREAS, according to the Philippine Cancer Society, breast cancer is the most common cancer disease and the leading cause of cancer deaths among Filipino women in the country today;

WHEREAS, the key to surviving breast cancer is early distoction and treatment. Medical experts claim that when a breast cancer is disconosed early and treated promptly, the probability that it can be cured is up to eighty five percent 45.5%);

WHEREAS, since breast cancer is the number one killer of Thomas women, the establishment of Breast Care Center in the Tu's Health Department will be a crucial starting point in our battle against it.

SECTION 1. Tale - This Ordinance shall be known as the mountainteen Dreimance in Quezon City."

number a simile awareness campaign to educate outsiders and women about the courses are in factors associated with breast cancer and its processor.

The public awareness campaign required by subsection I hereof shall meinde:

- a. How and when to do self-breast examination.
- b. The several identified risk factors such as family history, genetics, menstrual period that begun before age 12 and ended age 55, early and repeated exposures to relatively high doses of radiation, and long term post-menopausal estrogen replacement.
- 2. Conduct free clinical breast examination or mammogram and other services.
- 3. The Breast Care Center shall urge all constituents to recognize and support the National Breast Cancer Amareness Month celebrated every month of October.
- 4 Propide encouragement and assistance to organizations that offer educational, advocacy and support services for those who have breast cancer.

SECTION 6, anotementation — The Quezon City Health Department shall issue such guidelines, orders or rules and regulations as may be necessary for the establishment of the Breast Care Center. The acquisition of necessary equipment, tools, implements, devices and apparatus, biring of personnel and fixing of reasonable fees for the samples of the said breast care center shall be the department's duty.

In addition to this, the implementation of the integrated to every Darangay Heolth Centers to reach out Quezon City's underprivileged constituents.

SECTION I Appropriations — To fully implement the movisions of this Ordinance, the necessary amount shall be taken from the modifible funds of the Annual Executive Budget of the Cira Government.

SECTION 8. Repealing Clause - All ordinances, resolutions, local executive orders, rules and regulations or any part thereof inconsistent herewith an deemed repealed, modified or amended accordingly.

SECTION 9. Separability Clause – In case any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 10. Effectivity Clause - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
