ORDINANCE NO. SP-1941, S-2009,

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING BUS AND OTHER TRANSPORTATION OWNERS AND/OR OPERATORS WHOSE TERMINALS ARE SITUATED IN AND/OR WHOSE POINT OF ORIGIN AND/OR RETURN DESTINATIONS ARE IN QUEZON CITY TO DISPLAY A DESTINATION SIGNAGE THE WORD QUEZON CITY AS ITS PORT OF ORIGIN AND/OR DESTINATIONS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREOF.

WHEREAS, for public information, goodwill, promotion and public interest, it is but fitting to require the display of the word QUEZON CITY, as the point of origin and return destination coming from any point of the Philippines instead of names of Barangays, Streets, Mall Stores, etc. in all public conveyance both passengers and cargo.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

ARTICLE I
COVERAGES

SECTION 1. All owners, operators, drivers/conductors, inspectors are required to display a destination signage the word "QUEZON CITY" as its point of origin, stop over and/or of return destination coming from any point of the Philippines except public conveyances operating within Metro Manila and suburbs.


SECTION 2. Cargo vehicles, delivery vans whose terminals are situated in Quezon City are likewise included under these provisions.

SECTION 3. The signage word "QUEZON CITY TERMINAL" shall likewise be displayed at the terminal situated in Quezon City and any name to identify such terminal such as names of Barangays, malls, street, etc., may be allowed provided it does not exceed more than ten percent (10%) of the signage of QUEZON CITY TERMINAL indicated underneath.

ARTICLE II
FINAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 1. PENALTIES. - Any persons who violate any provisions of this ordinance shall suffer the penalty of not more than one (1) year of imprisonment or a fine of not more than Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) or both at the discretion of the court.






SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. - This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after the approval of this ordinance.


