A ORDINANCE MAKING ROAD 8 FROM ROAD 3 TO ALLEY 3 AND ROAD 2, FROM ROAD 8 DOWN TO ALLEY 6 BARANGAY PROJECT 6, QUEZON CITY, A ONE-WAY STREET EVERY SUNDAY FROM 6:00 A.M. TO 9:00 P.M.

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of Barangay Project 6 passed a Resolution to make Road 8 from Road 3 to Alley 3 and Road 2, from Road 8 down to Alley 6, a one-way street every Sunday from 6:00 am to 9:00 pm.



IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:


SECTION 1. Road 8 from Road 3 to Alley 3 and Road 2 from
