## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. All Streets inside the City Hall Complex are hereby named after the former Mayors of Quezon City.

SECTION 2. The Cultural and Tourism Affairs Office and the Quezon City Public Library shall establish the proper guidelines and appropriate ceremony pursuant to the fitting inauguration of the Streets.

SECTION 3. The City Engineer's Office and the City General Services Office are hereby mandated to install the Street Signs with the corresponding name of the former Mayor in every conspicuous corners.

SECTION 4. That a proper notification relative to this ordinance be given to the National Historical Institute.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
