AN ORDINANCE CREATING A CITY WIDE UNIFORM HOUSE NUMBERING SYSTEM/SCHEME IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, Section 16 thereof also known as the General Welfare Clause of the "Local Government Code of the Philippines" states that, "every local government unit xxx shall within their respective territorial jurisdictions xxx promote health and safety xxx maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants.;"

WHEREAS, house numbering in Quezon City is not in order, often a particular number is used twice in a single street in one barangay;

WHEREAS, there is a need to identify and assign permanent house numbering to all real estate owners in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, there is a need to eliminate the practice of certain developers in giving numbers not sanctioned by the City Government of Quezon City to their clientele which only adds confusion to the public;

WHEREAS, creating a uniform house numbering system/scheme would eradicate confusion among locators of addresses especially when such properties are located within the boundaries of two (2) or more barangays.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The Quezon City government shall coordinate with the City Planning and Development Office, Barangay Operations Center (BOC), City Assessors Office, Philippine Postal Corporation, National Statistic Office (NSO) and the Barangay in identifying, assigning and cause to effect the numbering sequence of all real estate properties, particularly along the boundaries of every barangay, to ensure uniformity, continuity in the implementation of the City Wide Uniform House Numbering System/Scheme.

SECTION 2. All land developers in Quezon City shall adopt and conform to the City Wide Uniform House Numbering System.

SECTION 3. All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations or part thereof which are found to be inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.




SECTION 4. In the event that any of the provision of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, all other which could stand independently thereof shall remain in force.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.




