ORDINANCE NO. SP 1969 S-2009

**AN ORDINANCE NAMING MAPAGBIGAY EXTENSION COMMONLY KNOWN AS BORACAY AND BAYWALK STREETS IN BARANGAY PINYAHAN, INTO MAUNLAD AND MAGILIW STREETS RESPECTIVELY, APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

*WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 07-2009 of the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Pinyahan, requesting the Quezon City Council to enact a corresponding Ordinance to formally name Boracay and Baywalk Streets in said Barangay into Maunlad and Magiliw Streets, respectively, there is a need for the City Council to take cognizant of the position of said barangay;*

*WHEREAS, for purposes of uniformity and easier identification, wherein all street in Barangay Pinyahan are named after the noted Filipino traits (e.g. Matatag, Malakas, Matahimik, etc), the proposed new name of Boracay and Baywalk Streets into Maunlad and Magiliw is but appropriate.*

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:**

**SECTION 1.** *The Mapagbigay Extension, commonly known as Boracay and Baywalk Streets in Barangay Pinyahan, are hereby named as Maunlad and Magiliw Streets, respectively.*



SECTION 2. The City Engineering Office and City Planning and Development Office are hereby directed to cause the installation of proper street signage and identification.


SECTION 3. Appropriation – The amount needed for the proper implementation of this Ordinance shall be taken from any available funds of the City Treasury.
