*AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FOR THE PAYMENT OF BUSINESS TAXES AND FEES FROM JANUARY 20, 2010 TO JANUARY 31, 2010.*

*WHEREAS, in view of the limitations of the existing manpower and facilities of the City Treasury to accommodate the large number of taxpayers paying their business taxes and fees for year 2010, the first quarter payment period from January 1 to 20, 2010 is deemed insufficient;*

*WHEREAS, in the interest of the tax-paying public of Quezon City, the deadline for payments should be extended to at least ten (10) days to accommodate business tax payments without penalty;*

*WHEREAS, in consideration of the limitation of the present collection system to service the voluminous number of taxpayers, the City may provide for an extended grace period of time to accept payments without penalty, but likewise, conform within the limits set by the existing laws and ordinances.*

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:


SECTION 1. Coverage - All annual and quarterly business taxes and fees payable to Quezon City Government for 2010 which is due to be paid on or before January 20, 2010 can be paid not later than January 31, 2010, without any penalty, surcharge or interest.

SECTION 2. Penalty and Interest - All business taxes and fees for the current period shall, however, be subject to twenty-five (25%) penalty and monthly interest of two percent (2%) in not paid on or before January 31, 2010.


SECTION 3. Repealing Clause - Any provision of law, executive order, or other rules and regulations inconsistent with the provision of this ordinance is hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. Effectivity - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.




