ORDINANCE NO. S-1973, S-2009

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING EIGHTEEN MILLION FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (P18,585,000.00) TO BE ALLOCATED FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OF NATIONAL GOVERNMENT CENTER EASTSIDE HOUSING PROJECTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Introduced by Councilor ALLAN BUICIT, FRANCISCO.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that "every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its essential and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, x x x enhance economic prosperity and social justice x x x";

WHEREAS, Section 458 (2) (c) of the Local Government Code empowers the local government units to appropriate supplemental budgets of the city government and appropriate funds for specific programs, projects, services and activities of the city, or for other purposes not yet contrary to law, in order to promote the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2003 Her Excellency, President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo, signed into law Republic Act No. 9207, otherwise known as the National Government Center Act of 2003, which concretely granted security of tenure to the bonafide residents of the NGC and laid down the area's utilization and development path for the purpose;

WHEREAS, subsequently, close to a year after the approval of the above mentioned law, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-1386, S-2004, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND APPROVING THE SITE DEVELOPMENT PLAN OF THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT CENTER-EASTSIDE DEVELOPMENT PROJECT PREPARED BY THE HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT COORDINATING COUNCIL, NATIONAL GOVERNMENT CENTER-EASTSIDE DEVELOPMENT PROJECT AND A. CLAVERIA SURVEYING" was enacted by the 15th City Council during its 90th Regular Session;

WHEREAS, the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9207 provides for the guidelines that shall be followed in the disposal of lands for socioeconomic, civic, educational, religious and other purposes based on the principles etched in R.A. No. 9207 and R.A. No. 7279 or the Urban Development and Housing Act;

WHEREAS, the completion of the community development and subdivision plan have yet to be finished and at the same time, the intended beneficiaries thereof are required to shoulder so much fees for the facilitation, payment for subdivision plan, processing and transfer of titles under their names, re-blocking, and for other purposes related for community development which amount they cannot afford to pay;

WHEREAS, the noble purpose of the program would be defeated and/or forfeited should the beneficiaries comply with their undertaking, hence the need to appropriate funds to be allocated for the same.

WHEREAS, the breakdown of herein mentioned expenses shall be submitted before the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:


Section 1. Appropriation - The amount of Eighteen Million Five Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Pesos (P18,585,000.00) is hereby appropriated for the approval of the Community Development Project of National Government Center-Eastside Projects and for other purposes.

Section 2. The Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. No. 9207 are hereto adopted for the implementation of this ordinance.


Section 3. The appropriation of the said amount shall be included in 2010 annual budget or in any available funds of the City Treasury of the City Government.

Section 4. Effectivity – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


