ORDINANCE NO. SP-1991S-2010

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF TEN MILLION PESOS (P10,000,000.00) TO BE CHARGED FROM GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE 2010 ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY TREASURY AS RESERVE FUND FOR THE 10TH NATIONAL COOPERATIVE SUMMIT IN 2010 WITH QUEZON CITY AS THE LOCAL HOST.

WHEREAS, Quezon City Local Government, through the City Development Council's Cooperative Sector has been very consistent in bidding for the hosting of the National Cooperative Summit;

WHEREAS, hosting of National Summit will boost local tourism providing opportunity to showcase the achievements of the present administration;

WHEREAS, the City Mayor signed Executive Order No. 13, S-2009 dated September 9, 2009 creating the Quezon City 10th National Cooperative Summit Organizing Committee, with its members and functions explicitly provided;

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a) (i) in relation to Rule 17 Article 98 of R.A. No. 7160, also known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers the City Council to approve ordinances, resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the City and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of the same Code and to provide efficient and effective provision for basic services and facilities;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17 (4) (g) and (b) of the same code, the basic services and facilities hereinabove mentions shall be funded from the share of local government units in the proceeds of the national taxes and other local revenues and funding support from the National Government, its instrumentalities and government-owned or controlled corporations and any fund or resource available for the use of local government units shall be first allocated for the provision of services of facilities enumerated in the foregoing provisions of the same Code before applying the same for other purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated the total amount of Ten Million Pesos (P10,000,000.00) as a reserved fund for the hosting of the 10th National Cooperative Summit in 2010.

SECTION 2. The 10th National Cooperative Summit Organizing Committee is directed to promulgate Implementing Rules and Regulations regarding the implementation of the project, release disbursement of funds as provided for under this ordinance.


SECTION 3. Repealing Clause - All ordinances, resolutions, executive orders, directives, instruction and implementing rules and regulations inconsistent with provisions of this Ordinance are hereby accordingly repealed.


