ORDINANCE NO. SP-**2007**S-2010

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC AND DESIGNATING CERTAIN STREET AS ONE WAY, ONE-SIDE PARKING AREA, NO PARKING AREA, AND OTHER TRAFFIC REGULATION WITHIN BARANGAY WHITE PLAINS, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No.7160 provides that "A local government unit may, pursuant to an ordinance, regulate traffic on all streets and bridges; prohibit encroachments or obstacles thereon and, when necessary in the interest of public welfare, authorize the removal of encroachments and illegal constructions in public places";

WHEREAS, Republic Act No.7160, also known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the function of the Barangay is to "submit to the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang Bayan such suggestions or recommendations as it may see fit for the improvement of Barangay or for the welfare of the inhabitants thereof";

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of Barangay White Plains sought the assistance of the city government to regulate the flow of traffic within Barangay White Plains, designating, "One Way", "No Parking Area", "Speed Limits", Gross Weight, Axle and Wheel Loads in Barangay White Plains, Quezon City through their Barangay Resolution No. 4-30, S-2009;

WHEREAS, the abovementioned measures though to a certain extent effective have not presently been able to provide smooth flow of traffic within Barangay White Plains at all time;

WHEREAS, there is a need to regulate the gross weight, axle and loads of trailer trucks concrete mixers, delivery vans, low-bed trucks or trailers and other similar vehicles carrying construction materials and other materials because the roads inside Barangay White Plains are not build to withstand such weight.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. No Parking. - There shall be No Parking:

- a. At the designated corners of road leading to Queensville Executive Villas coming from Queensville Court
- b. Along Roads opposite the designated sides for parking, even if the whole or part of the vehicle is on the sidewalk
- c. On the portion of Roadside where parking is permitted, when a vehicle gate is located on the opposite side
- d. Within Six (6) meters of all road corners
- e. Five (5) meters before and after each fire hydrant to facilitate use by firetrucks during emergencies

SECTION 2. It is hereby declared as ONE SIDE PARKING the left side of the following streets in Barangay White Plains:

1. Derby St.
2. Goldstar St.
3. Greystone St.
4. Sarangaya St.
5. Nathan St.
6. Queensville St.
7. Charleyville St.
8. Pinesville St.
9. Greenhill St.
10. Yellowstone St.
11. Fernsville St.
12. Oakville St.


SECTION 3. The entry of Six (6) wheelers and above truck/s within Barangay White Plains is prohibited. Ten (10) wheelers concrete Mixer and other similar vehicle shall be allowed subject to the approval of the Barangay.

SECTION 4. Speed Limit within Barangay White Plains is regulated to 30 kph on flat roads and 20 kph on descending roads.


SECTION 5. The Department of Public Order and Safety (DPoS) and the Barangay Council of Barangay White Plains shall ensure the strict implementation of this Ordinance and are hereby given plenary powers and authority to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


