



Ordinance No. SP- 82, S-93

ORDINANCE

CREATING THE PERMANENT POSITIONS OF SERGEANT-AT-ARMS AND THREE (3) DEPUTY SERGEANTS-AT-ARMS FOR THE QUEZON CITY COUNCIL AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, an atmosphere of security and the continuous existence of peace and order for any law-making body such as the Quezon City Council are prime requisites for the smooth flow of its activities;

WHEREAS, per Resolution No. SP-13, S-92, there are at present temporarily designated Sergeant-At-Arms assigned to the Quezon City Council coming from the members of the Central Police District, Quezon City Hall Police Security Force whose duties and responsibilities consist of providing security and maintenance of peace and order during Council Sessions and its other related activities;

WHEREAS, the nature of the temporary assignment of the incumbent Sergeant-At-Arms to the City Council is such a state of uncertainty that when the presently designated Sergeant-At-Arms are recalled to their Mother Unit the situation will definitely create a vacuum and undue disturbance to the City Council's needs for security and peace and order in their undertakings;

WHEREAS, the temporarily assigned peace officers to the City Council are extended incentives from the City Government which maybe construed as a form of double compensation in violation of the constitutional provisions and other existing laws;

WHEREAS, non-full time assignment to the City Council of the present contingent of Sergeant-At-Arms does not only hamper the activities of the City Council but likewise run-counter to the objective of the PNP Law requiring full concentration of peace enforcers in active service to be at their units of assignment in order to ensure the protection of the City residents and combat criminalities;

WHEREAS, the retired policemen of the Quezon City Central Police District who are still physically fit and able to do job of Sergeant-At-Arms are sources of manpower requirement who can aptly and sufficiently provide security and maintain peace and order for all activities of the City Council including that of the committee meetings;

WHEREAS, in view of the urgent necessity to inject professionalism to the assigned tasks of Sergeant-At-Arms for the City Council, it is therefore a reality to create the permanent positions of one (1) Sergeant-At-Arms and three (3) Deputy Sergeants-At-Arms and the persons to assume the positions shall render services on full-time basis;

WHEREAS, the allocation of the necessary amount is required to subsidize the salaries and other benefits in line with the creation of the subject positions, the amount broken down as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There shall be created permanent positions of one (1) Sergeant-At-Arms and three (3)

Deputy Sergeants-At-Arms for the Quezon City Council whose duties and powers are as follows:

- (a) To attend the session, committee meetings, public hearings and other similar activities of the City Council;
- (b) To be responsible for the security and maintenance of order in the session hall, corridors and offices of the Council, whether in session or not, in accordance with the orders of the City Council thru the Presiding Officer;
- (c) To execute or serve, personally the summons or notice which may be issued by the Councils' Regular or Special Committee or by the City Council and the Presiding Officer; and
- (d) To perform other duties inherent in this office of the Sergeant-At-Arms.

SECTION 2. That the Sergeant-At-Arms shall be responsible for the strict compliance by his three (3) Deputy Sergeants-At-Arms of their respective duties. He may impose upon them corrective or disciplinary measures for just cause, including a recommendation to the City Council thru the City Secretary for their dismissal.

SECTION 3. That those to be appointed as Sergeant-At-Arms and the three (3) Deputy Sergeants-At-Arms shall be taken preferably from the retired policemen of the Central Police District, Philippine National Police.

SECTION 4. There shall be allocation of the amount of ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-NINE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY THREE and 69/100 PESOS (P189,733.69) or so much thereof as may be necessary from the funds of the City Council, for the attainment of this purpose, computed as follows:




SECTION 5. That any Ordinance or Resolution inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be considered repealed and/or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 1993.


