## ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF A PROCESSING/DOCUMENT-ATION FEE AMOUNTING TO THIRTY PESOS (\$30.00) PER APPLICANT IN CONNECTION WITH THE SOCIALIZED HOUSING PROGRAM OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT.

Introduced by Councilor Alberto M. Galarpe. Sponsored by Councilors Isidro R. Saludes, Wilma A. Sarino, Dante V. Liban and Edgardo S. Serrano.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government has embarked on a Socialized Housing Project for the benefit of the low income group of its constituents, its employees and those identified as program beneficiaries of declared blighted areas in the City which is estimated to be close to 200,000 families;

WHEREAS, there is a need to evaluate each application for the purpose of determining whether the applicant is qualified for the program and said process will entail additional expense for the City Government;

WHEREAS, there is a need to provide funds for the purpose;

## NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. The amount of thirty pesos (\$70.00) shall be collected from each applicant availing of the benefits of the City's Socialized Housing Program which will constitute as processing/documentation fee for the evaluation of their application.

SECTION 2. The imposition of fees would act as regulatory measure for application screening procedures so that applicants/beneficiaries would be more responsible and careful in filing their application and to discourage those who are disqualified from availing of the program.

SECTION 3. The target beneficiaries of the Socialized Housing Program include those families belonging to the low-income group and local government employees numbering 100,000.00 families and those identified program beneficiaries of declared blighted areas of the City which is estimated to run close to 100,000 families.

SECTION 4. Awardees under the Socialized Housing Program shall pay an award fee of One Hundred Pesos (\$100.00)

SECTION 5. The funds collected pursuant to this ordinance shall be treated as Special/Trust Fund and shall be spent to attain the purpose above-provided.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
