

Ordinance No. NC-86, S-89

ORDINANCE
CREATING A LIQUOR LICENSING AND REGULATORY BOARD
UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR COMPOSED OF A
CHAIRMAN AND TWO MEMBERS, AND PROVIDING FUNDS FOR
THE PURPOSE.

Introduced by Councilor Alberto M. Galarpe.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and of utmost importance that a Liquor Licensing and Regulatory Board shall be created to take charge and undertake efficient implementation of liquor provisions approved under Ordinance No. NC-85, S-89;

WHEREAS, in highly urbanized city like Quezon City, the Liquor Licensing and Regulatory Board is indeed beneficial and very effective to regulate the establishment and operation of the liquor business in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the implementation and enforcement of the liquor ordinance assigned to government agencies preclude too much red tapes and illegal activities if other agency is tasked with the same duty;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. LIQUOR LICENSING AND REGULATORY BOARD - There is hereby created a Liquor Licensing and Regulatory Board under the office of the City Mayor, composed of a Chairman and two (2) members to implement the provisions of Liquor Ordinance No. NC-85, S-89.

SECTION 2. The Chairman and two (2) members shall be appointed by the City Mayor for a definite period, but not beyond the term of the appointing power.

The Board shall meet in regular session twice a week and in special session not more than four (4) time in a month, and the presence of the chairman and any one member shall constitute a quorum and their acts shall be deemed as official acts of the Board for every meeting thereof, the Chairman shall

be entitled to a per diem of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) and the two (2) members to a per diem of Four Hundred Pesos (P400.00) each per session.

SECTION 3. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES - The Liquor Licensing and Regulatory Board shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. To take charge of the processing of application to operate and/or engage in the business;
- b. To have general supervision and control over the operation and establishment of all liquor manufacturers, distilleries, distributors, dealers, wholesalers and retailers of liquor and/or intoxicating beverages operating in Quezon City;
- c. To promulgate rules, regulations and guidelines that may be necessary for the proper implementation of the provisions of Ordinance No. 85, S-89;
- d. To call upon and/or utilize any Department, Bureau, Office, Agency or instrumentality, public or private, for such assistance as it may require in the performance of its functions; and
- e. To perform such functions as provided by Law.

SECTION 4. PERSONNEL COMPOSITION - To carry on, man and execute the functions of the Liquor Licensing and Regulatory Board, the following personnel composition is hereby created:

One (1)	Executive Officer	P5,000.00/mo.
One (1)	Receptionist Secretary ...	3,000.00/mo.
Five (5)	Processors	3,000.00/mo. (ea)
One (1)	Recorder	2,000.00/mo.
One (1)	File Clerk	2,000.00/mo.
Two (2)	Clerk-Typist	2,000.00/mo. (ea)
One (1)	Driver-Messenger	2,000.00/mo.

SECTION 5. APPROPRIATIONS FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF REQUIREMENTS FOR THE FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARD - There is hereby appropriated the amount of One Million Pesos (P1,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary from the available funds in the City Treasury for the funding of all requirements of the Board, including per diem, salaries of the personnel and maintenance of operating expenses.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE - All existing ordinances, rules and regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If any provision of this Code is held invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall continue in operation.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
