ORDINANCE

PPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS

P500,000,000 FOR THE ACQUISITION OF THE LIFE-SIZE WAX

TATUE OF THE LATE PRESIDENT MANUEL L. QUEZON.

Introduced by Councilor George Canseco.

WHEREAS, on February 15, 1989, Resolution No. NC-235, 5-89, entitled "RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. BRIGILO R. SIMON, JR., TO NEGOTIATE FOR THE ACQUISITION OF THE LIFE-SIZE STATUE OF THE LATE PRESIDENT MANUEL L. QUEZON" has adopted by the Quezon City Council;

WHEREAS, the City Mayor, Hon, Brigido R. Simon, Jr., by wirtue of said resolution had negotilated for the acquisition of said statu;

WHEREAS, the quoted price for the statue by the widow of the late National Artist Guillermo Tolentino is FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (\$\mathbb{P}\$500,000.00);

WHEREAS, curators assigned by Cultural Committee from the Quezon City Government appraised the statue at 1.5 million Fesos and could have been sold for even more, the item being priceless;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the Caty Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. There is beneby appropriated from the unappropriated funds of the Caty Treasury the amount of FIVE EINDRED THOUSAND PESOS (PEOC. 000.00) for the acquisition of the life-size wax statue of the late President Manuel L. Quezon from the widow of the late Sculptor National Artist Guillermo Telentine.

SECTION 2. The statue mentioned in Section One hereof shall be kept at all times at the Quezon City Museum.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
