

Ordinance No. NC- 100, S-89

ORDINANCE

APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P500,000.00) FOR THE ACQUISITION OF THE LIFE-SIZE WAX STATUE OF THE LATE PRESIDENT MANUEL L. QUEZON.

Introduced by Councillor George Canseco.

WHEREAS, on February 16, 1989, Resolution No. NC-235, S-89, entitled "RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. BRIGIDO R. SIMON, JR., TO NEGOTIATE FOR THE ACQUISITION OF THE LIFE-SIZE STATUE OF THE LATE PRESIDENT MANUEL L. QUEZON" was adopted by the Quezon City Council;

WHEREAS, the City Mayor, Hon. Brigido R. Simon, Jr., by virtue of said resolution had negotiated for the acquisition of said statue;

WHEREAS, the quoted price for the statue by the widow of the late National Artist Guillermo Tolentino is FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P500,000.00);

WHEREAS, curators assigned by Cultural Committee from the Quezon City Government appraised the statue at 1.5 million Pesos and could have been sold for even more, the item being priceless;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated funds of the City Treasury the amount of FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P500,000.00) for the acquisition of the life-size wax statue of the late President Manuel L. Quezon from the widow of the late Sculptor National Artist Guillermo Tolentino.

SECTION 2. The statue mentioned in Section One hereof shall be kept at all times at the Quezon City Museum.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
