ORDINANCE

IMPOSING A FIFTY-CENTAVOS (₱0.50) TAX ON PATRONS OF MOVIE HOUSES IN QUEZON CITY TO BE KNOWN AS SPECIAL FOUNDATION TAX, FOR THE PERIOD AUGUST 1, 1989 TO OCTOBER 12, 1989.

WHEREAS, Quezon City will be celebrating its golden jubilee (50th year) on October 12, 1989;

WHEREAS, it is but fitting and proper that government officials and employees of this City, as well as its residents, shall participate in the celebration of such historic and significant event, by way of commemorating through meaningful activities which could serve to honor and venerate the virtues that made Quezon City what it is today;

WHEREAS, for the success of the celebration of said event, the City Government will need no less than the combined and collective effort and support, not only of the City Government employees and officials and non-governmental organizations, but most importantly, of the City residents thru their material contributions for the said purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. IMPOSITION OF TAX. There is hereby imposed on patrons of movie houses in Quezon City for the period from August 1, 1989 to October 12, 1989, a special foundation tax of Fifty-Centavos (₱0.50) per patron, including those covered by complimentary tickets or passes.

SECTION 2. PAYMENT AND REMITTANCE. It shall be the duty of operators of movie houses to withhold the tax and remit the same to the City Treasurer within the first twenty (20) days of the following month, in the same manner as the amusement tax and cultural development tax are remitted to the City Treasurer's Office.

SECTION 3. PENALTIES. Failure to remit the tax imposed under this Ordinance within the prescribed period shall subject the operator of movie houses to a surcharge

of twenty five percent (25%) plus interest upon the unpaid amount at the rate of one percent (1%) monthly or fraction thereof after the due date until the tax is fully paid.

SECTION 4. DISPOSITION OF PROCEEDS. Income realized from this Ordinance shall be spent solely for the Golden Jubilee Celebration of Quezon City.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect on August 1, 1989.
