ORDINANCE
 REQUIRING OWNERS AND/OR OPERATORS OF COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS
 TO MAINTAIN CLEAN AND PROPERLY FUNCTIONING REST/COMFORT ROOMS
 AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in
 session assembled:

Section 1. It shall be mandatory for owners and/or
 operators of commercial establishments such as food es-
 tablishments, stadia, coliseums, beer houses, recreation
 facilities, malls, shopping centers, supermarkets and
 other establishments of similar nature to maintain in
 good repair/condition clean and properly functioning
 rest/comfort rooms.

Section 2. The authorized representatives of the
 Quezon City Department of Health and the City Cultural
 and Tourism Affairs Office and Business Permits and
 Licenses Office shall promulgate the rules and regula-
 tions to implement said Ordinance and shall conduct re-
 gular inspection on their business premises.

Section 3. a) Violation of this Ordinance shall be
 penalized by a fine of not more than One Thousand Pesos
 (P1,000.00) or imprisonment of not more than thirty (30)
 days, or both at the discretion of the Court. If the
 violation is committed by a juridical person, the penalty
 provided for under this Ordinance shall be imposed upon
 the President, General Manager or Owner or Operator
 thereof. b) Repeated violations of this Ordinance shall
 cause the cancellation and/or revocation of the business
 permit or licenses of said establishment.
