ORDINANCE

ALLOTING THE AMOUNT OF P150,000.00 FROM THE SPECIAL ACTIVITIES FUND OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR TO UNDERWRITE THE STUDY AND REVISION OF THE QUEZON CITY CHARTER TO BE UNDERTAKEN BY THE COMMITTEE ON LAWS, RULES AND INTERNAL GOVERNMENT.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. The Committee on Laws, Rules and Internal Government is hereby designated to conduct studies on the revision of the Quezon City Charter, as amended, and to submit to the City Council a proposed Revised Charter of Quezon City which shall be forwarded to Congress for the enactment of the necessary legislation thereon.

SECTION 2. The Committee may engage the services of legal, technical and/or support staff to assist it in the performance of its tasks.

SECTION 3. The Committee shall submit its report and the proposed Revised Charter of Quezon City within a period of three (3) months from the approval of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. The amount of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (P150,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby allotted from the Special Activities Fund of the Office of the City Mayor to cover the expenses for consultancy, research and other necessary expenses of the aforesaid purpose.

SECTION 5. Any and all existing ordinance, resolution and prior acts of the City Council which are inconsistent here herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

SECTION 2. The Board shall be assisted in its tasks by a Support Staff, the composition of which will be appointed by the Mayor upon the recommendation of the Board and shall have the following responsibilities:

1. Undertake research and special studies as may be necessary in support of the economic development program of the City.
