## ORDINANCE NO. NC- 63, 5188

## ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS OF THE QUEZON CITY COUNCIL TO UNDERTAKE A STUDY, FOR PURPOSES OF REVIEW, REVISION, AMENDMENT, UPDATING AND CODIFICATION OF EXISTING TAX LAWS, REVENUE CODES, ORDINANCES, RULES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO COLLECTION OF REVENUES FOR THE CITY, AND PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, the present tax laws, ordinances and the City revenue code are already outmoded, mostly obsolete and not conforming with the present standard and conditions as expected in the proper collection of revenues for the City thereby causing the City to lose huge amount of revenues and to miss the proper application of regulatory measures suited and applicable to the present standard of business operations;

## NOW, TEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the quezon City Council in session assembled:

SECTION 1. The Committee on Ways and Means is hereby tasked to undertake a study, for purposes of review, amending, updating and codification of existing tax laws, revenue codes, ordinances, rules and regulations pertaining to collection of revenues for quezon City.

SECTION 2. For the realization of this purpose, the Committee is hereby authorized to engage the services of the National Tax Research Center, City Officials and

employees of the different revenue generating offices of the City Government and other legal and technical agencies and expertists to assist the Committee in the undertaking.

SECTION 3. Ninety (90) days from the approval of this ordinance, the Committee is required to submit a progress report to the City Council on the project.

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (P200,000.00) or so much as may be necessary, from unappropriated funds in the City Treasury, to cover the expenses of the undertaking.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days from its approval.
