ORDINANCE

REQUIRE G THE PLANTING OF TREES, PROHIBITING ITS DESTRUCTION IN PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFOR.

Introduced by Councilor Alberto M. Galarpe.

WHETEAS, plants and trees are necessary to maintain and preserve the ecological balance of the community;

WIREAS, the erosion of rivers and creeks can best be reevented by the planting of trees along its banks;

open spaces provides beauty, shade and healthful climate for the community;

## MOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

Section 1. The following shall plant trees in accordance with the provisions of PD 935;

- a. Every person who owns land adjoining an existing river or creek, shall plant trees extending at least five meters on his land adjoining the edge of the bank of the river or creek.
- b. Every owner of an existing subdivision shall plant trees in the open spaces required to be reserved for the common use and enjoyment of the owners of the lote therein as well as along all moads and service ETROUTE.
- section 2. The planting of fruit-bearing trees or economic value shall be the center of activities carried the celebration of "Arbor Week" in Quezon City cal count 2-, of every year as per City Council Re-solution No. 130, S-88 particularly clong the main thoroug meres, open spaces, parks and playgrounds with-in the territorial jurisdiction of Quezon City.

Section 3. At the Barangay level, all Barangay Officials and school authorities including officers and members of PTA shall be the prime movers in pursting the objective of celebration, by implementing true planting projects and giving instructions and guidance to school children-participants, and infusing in their minds the significance and importance of planting trees to one's environment.
