ORDINANCE No. 9239-1, S-72

ORDINANCE

REQUIRING DRUG COMPANIES IN QUEZON CITY TO SUBMIT A MONTHLY REPORT ON THE SALES OF BARBITURATES: AMPHETAMINES AND OTHER PROHIBITED DRUGS (SEDATIVES AND STIMULANTS), STATING THE SOURCE OF THE DRUGS VOLUME OF SALES, AND THE NAMES AND ADDRESSES OF THE PHYSICIANS WITH THEIR CORRESPONDING LICENSE NUMBER WHO PRESCRIBED THE SAID DRUGS OR MEDICINES: AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City  
in session assembled:

SECTION 1. All drug companies in Quezon City are hereby required to submit a monthly report on the sales of barbiturates, amphetamines and other prohibited drugs (sedatives and stimulants) stating the source of the drugs, volume of sales, and the names and addresses of the physicians with their corresponding license number who prescribed the said drugs or medicines. The original copy of the said monthly report for each month, which must be duly signed by the owner, president, manager of the drug company shall be submitted to the Office of the City Mayor, within five days of the succeeding month.

SEC. 2. This ordinance shall supplement and/or amend accordingly. Ordinance No. 8016, S-69.

SEC. 3. Any violation of the provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction be penalized by a fine of not more than TWO HUNDRED PESOS (P200.00) and an imprisonment of not more than six (6) months. In case of corporation or partnership or any juridical entity, the president, the general manager or the person in charge of the business establishment shall be held liable under this Ordinance.

SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
