ORDINANCE NO. 9237, S-72

ORDINANCE  
PROHIBITING ALL PUBLIC UTILITY BUSES TO ENTER ESCALER  
STREET, DILIMAN DISTRICT, QUEZON CITY; AND PROVIDING  
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, Escaler Street forms a horse-shoe street  
on the right side of Katipunan Street as traversed from  
the University of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, it is impractical and inadvisable for  
public utility buses coming from the University of the  
Philippines to enter and/or maneuver for a "U" turn  
or park along Escaler Street considering its width and  
length;

WHEREAS, the residents along said street have  
been complaining of "for hire vehicles" entering and/or  
parking therein;

WHEREAS, such entry and/or parking in said street  
endanger the lives of minor children aside from causing  
considerable noise and inconvenience to the residents  
in the neighborhood.

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City  
in session assembled:

SECTION 1. It is hereby prohibited for all public  
utility buses to enter Escaler Street, Diliman District,  
Quezon City.

SEC. 2. Any violation of the provision of this  
Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than

TEN PESOS (P10.00) or imprisonment of not more than five (5) days or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
