ORDINANCE

PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE IN PRIVATE MARKETS IN QUEZON CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Introduced by the Committees on Laws & Health

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City
in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Owners, administrators and/or operators of private markets and 'talipapa' in Quezon City are hereby required to provide for the collection and disposal of garbage thereat at their own expense, subject to sanitary standards and requirements provided for by city ordinances and/or rules and regulations on public hygiene and sanitation.

SEC. 2. In order to insure implementation of this Ordinance, the said private markets and 'talipapa' shall be subject to inspection and supervision of the Division of City Public Services and the Sanitary Division of the Health Department, this City.

SEC. 3. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than Fifty Pesos (P50.00) or imprisonment of not less than thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court, and shall be sufficient cause for the revocation of the license or permit of the market concerned; Provided, that for purposes of this Ordinance, the accumulation of uncollected garbage or refuse for two (2) days or more within a perimeter of fifty (50) meters from any private market or 'talipapa' shall constitute as prima-facie violation of this Ordinance.

If the violation is committed by a corporation, partnership, or any juridical entity, the manager, the managing director, or person in charge of the business entity, shall be responsible therefor.

SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than Fifty Pesos (P500.00) or imprisonment of not less than thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court, and shall be sufficient cause for the revocation of the license or permit of the market concerned; Provided, that for purposes of this Ordinance, the accumulation of uncollected garbage or refuse for two (2) days or more within a perimeter of fifty (50) meters from any private market or "talipapa" shall constitute as prima-facie violation of this Ordinance.

If the violation is committed by a corporation, partnership, or any juridical entity, the manager, the managing director, or person in charge of the business of the said corporation, partnership, or juridical entity, shall be responsible therefor.

SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
