ORDINANCE NO. 5998, S-64

ORDINANCE

PROHIBITING PERSONS BELOW TWENTY-ONE YEARS OLD FROM ENTERING AND FOR THE OPERATORS FROM ALLOWING SUCH PERSONS TO ENTER NIGHT CLUBS OR BARS OR OTHER NIGHT SPOTS IN QUEZON CITY WHICH EMPLOY HOSTESSES OR TAXI DANCERS DURING THE BUSINESS HOURS OF SAID NIGHT CLUBS OR BARS OR NIGHT SPOTS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREFOR.

Introduced by Councilor Bermúdez

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person below twenty-one years old to enter and for any operator to allow such persons in night clubs, bars or other night spots in Quezon City which employ hostesses or taxi dancers during the business hours of said night clubs, bars or night spots.

Sec. 2. The prohibition stated in the preceding section shall not apply during party celebrations such as birthdays, civic and school affairs; provided, that services of hostesses or taxi dancers are not engaged on such occasions.

Sec. 3. For any violation hereof there shall be imposed a fine of not less than Fifty (P50.00) Pesos or imprisonment of not less than twenty (20) days but not more than six (6) months.

In the case of a firm, partnership, corporation, or association, the manager, administrator or the person who has charge of the management or administration of the business shall be held personally liable for the violation thereof; and the municipal license or permit granted to such business shall be revoked and the establishment shall be closed.

Sec. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
