## ORDINANCE No. 60-4364

ORDINANCE
AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBERED THIRTY-NINE HUNDRED THIRTYTWO AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Introduced by Councilors Yabut & Diamonon

## Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance Numbered Thirtynine hundred thirty-two Series of 1959 is amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 2. Large cattle and other domestic animals found roaming at large or fettered in streets, high-ways and other public places in Quezon City shall be subject to apprehension and impounding in the City corall. When impounded such animals may be redeemed by the owner upon payment to the City Treasurer of impounding fees as follows:

Large cattle, Ten Pesos per head a day or fraction thereof; pigs, goats, sheep, Five Pesos per head a day or fraction thereof, Dogs, Two Pesos per head a day or fraction thereof, Provided, That impounded animals not claimed and redeemed Ten days after the date of impounding shall be sold for cost."

Sect 2. Sections 3 and 4 of the same Ordinance and Ordinance Numbered Thirty-eight hundred fifty-one Series of 1958 are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect March 15, 1960, Provided, That copies of the same shall be posted in public places in Quezon City.
