

ORDINANCE No. 60-4372

ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE No. 60-4367 GRANTING
RETIREMENT TO MEMBERS OF THE QUEZON CITY POLICE DEPART-
MENT UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

Introduced by the Committee on Public Safety

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City in
session assembled:

Section 1. Sections 1 and 3 of Ordinance No. 60-4367
granting retirement to members of the Quezon City Police
Department under certain conditions are hereby amended
so as to read as follows:

"Section 1. In accordance with the provisions
of Republic Act No. 660, and subject to the appro-
val of the Government Service Insurance System,
and of the City Council, members of the Quezon City
Police Department who have rendered at least ten years
service may, if they so elect, retire from the
service, provided that those eligible under
Commonwealth Act No. 186, as amended, who avail of
the benefits provided therein, or those members of
the police force who are under preventive suspension,
shall not be entitled to the benefits under this
Ordinance."

"Sec. 3. This Ordinance shall be in effect
until April 30, 1960, and to establish the right
to retire under this Ordinance application for
retirement must be filed not later than the said
date."

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect on its
approval.
