ORDINANCE NO. SP- **2552**, S-2016

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2017 IN THE AMOUNT OF SEVENTEEN BILLION SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY MILLION PESOS (P17,720,000,000.00) COVERING THE VARIOUS EXPENDITURES FOR THE OPERATION OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, the Local Chief Executive submitted to the Sangguniang Panlungsod, through the Office of the City Secretary, the proposed budget of the city on October 18, 2016;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code provides that on or before the end of the current fiscal year, the Sangguniang concerned shall enact through an ordinance, the annual budget of the local government unit for the ensuing fiscal year on the basis of the estimates of income and expenditures;

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to pass this Ordinance to support the financial needs and expenditures of the City Government for the year 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The Annual Budget of the Quezon City Government for Calendar Year 2017 is hereby approved in the amount of Seventeen Billion Seven Hundred Twenty Million Pesos (Php17,720,000,000.00) covering the various expenditures for the operation of the City Government.

The budget documents consisting of the following are incorporated herein and made an integral part of this Ordinance:


1. Budget Message of the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista;
2. Statement of Receipts;
3. Statement of Receipts and Expenditures;
4. Consolidated Programmed Appropriations and Obligations by Object of Expenditures;
5. Statement of Statutory and Contractual Obligation and Budgetary Requirements;
6. Statement of Fund Operations; and
7. Personnel schedule

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund the sum of Seventeen Billion Seven Hundred Twenty Million Pesos (Php17,720,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to be taken from the Estimate of Revenue certified as available for appropriation by the City Treasurer as contained in the budget documents. †



SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


