ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2567 , S-2017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO SP-2344, SERIES OF 2014, EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FOR THE DELINQUENT BENEFICIARIES THE PERIOD TO AVAIL THE PROVISIONS THEREOF, FROM 5 OCTOBER 2016 TO 5 OCTOBER 2017.



WHEREAS, Section 129 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991," provides that, Each local government unit shall exercise its power to create its own sources of revenue and to levy taxes, fees and charges subject to the provision herein, consistent with the basic policy of local autonomy. Such taxes, fees, and charges shall accrue exclusively to the local governments;

WHEREAS, the "Local Government Code of 1991", authorizes local government units to create their own sources of revenues to defray the expenses of government operations;







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WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-91, S-93 otherwise known as the "Quezon City Revenue Code" along with its amendments, provides standardized rates for tax payments, fees and other charges;

WHEREAS, the Implementing Guidelines Relative to the availment of the restructuring program of the Quezon City Government under Ordinance No. 2344, S-2014 provides, "SECTION 3. PERIOD OF AVAILMENT – The Restructuring of Account Program shall be availed of by the awardees-beneficiaries under the Socialized Housing Project (Direct Sale) upon the effectivity of the Guidelines and may be extended upon written approval of the City Mayor";

WHEREAS, there is a need to provide sufficient time for delinquent beneficiaries under Ordinance No. SP-2344, Series of 2014, entitled: "Restructuring the Account Balance of the delinquent beneficiaries of Samahang Magkakapitbahay, Inc., Barangay San Jose, District I, Quezon City, and other similarly-situated Urban Poor Housing Projects under the Direct Sale Program of the Quezon City Government." reasonable time to update their amortization payments without incurring penalties or interests.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT – The deadline for Delinquent Beneficiaries availing of the provisions under Ordinance No. SP-2344, Series of 2014 is hereby amended and extended from 5 October 2016 to 5 October 2017, for the purpose of providing the Delinquent Beneficiaries sufficient time from the implementation of the restructuring of account program of the Quezon City Government (QCG).

SECTION 2. REPEALING CLAUSE - All Ordinances, Resolutions, Executive Orders, Memorandum Circulars and Administrative Orders and Regulations or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

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SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – If for any reason(s), any part or provision of the Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, the other parts or provision hereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE – This Ordinance shall take effect after Fifteen (15) days after its complete publication in at least one (1) newspaper of general circulation.
