

ORDINANCE No. 60-4383

ORDINANCE

AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE No. 60-4373, CURRENT SERIES, CREATING THE POSITIONS OF ONE HUNDRED PROBATIONARY PATROLMEN IN THE QUEZON CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT, SUCH THAT THE APPROPRIATION NECESSARY SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE FUNDS SET ASIDE FOR LEAVES OF ABSENCE IN THE CITY TREASURY.

Introduced by the Committee on Appropriations & Finance

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 60-4373, current series, creating the positions of one hundred probationary patrolmen in the Quezon City Police Department is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. For purposes of this Ordinance the sum of Twenty-four Thousand (P24,000.00) Pesos or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated to cover the salaries of the said Patrolmen for the period of two months, the said amount to be taken from the reserved funds (leaves of absence) in the City Treasury."

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect as of March 14, 1960.
