

ORDINANCE No. 60-4396

ORDINANCE

PROHIBITING THE USE OF RUBBER HOSE IN FETCHING WATER FROM ANY PUBLIC FAUCET MAINTAINED BY THE CITY, AND THE TAPPING OF ANY PUBLIC WATER SERVICE LINE IN QUEZON CITY WITHOUT SECURING APPROVAL OF THE CITY COUNCIL, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.


Introduced by Councilor Albert

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to use rubber hose in fetching water from any public faucet maintained by the City, or to tap any public water service line in Quezon City, without securing approval of the City Council for subconnection to any additional faucet or private house or lot.

Sec. 2. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not exceeding \$200.00 or an imprisonment of not more than Two months, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.
