

ORDINANCE No. 60-4403

ORDINANCE

APPROPRIATING FIVE HUNDRED PESOS TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES FOR THE SUBSISTENCE OF FOUR OFFICERS AND TWELVE PATROLMEN OF THE QUEZON CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT TO BE DETAILED ON FULL TIME DUTY AS INSTRUCTORS DURING THE NINE WEEKS TRAINING COURSE FOR ONE HUNDRED POLICE RECRUITS, SCHEDULED TO START LAST APRIL 18, 1960.

Introduced by Committee on Public Safety

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any available funds existing in the city treasury the sum of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to defray the expenses for subsistence of four (4) officers and twelve (12) patrolmen of the Quezon City Police Department to be detailed on full time duty as instructors during the nine weeks training course for one hundred police recruits, scheduled to start last April 18, 1960.

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect on its approval.
