

ORDINANCE No. 60-4439

ORDINANCE

APPROPRIATING ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY-TWO PESOS IN ADDITION TO THE AMOUNT SET ASIDE UNDER ORDINANCE NO. 60-4403, TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES FOR SUBSISTENCE OF OFFICERS AND MEMBERS OF THE QUEZON CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT DETAILED IN FULL TIME DUTY AS INSTRUCTORS DURING THE TRAINING COURSE FOR POLICE RECRUITS FROM APRIL 18, 1960 TO JUNE 18, 1960.

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated in addition to the \$500.00 appropriated under Ordinance No. 60-4403, the sum of One Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty-two Pesos (\$1,732.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to defray the expenses for subsistence of officers and members of the Quezon City Police Department detailed in full time duty as instructors during the training course for 100 police recruits, from April 18, 1960 to June 18, 1960, at the rate of Eighty Centavos (P0.80) per meal or Two Pesos and Forty Centavos per day each, the amount to be taken from any available fund existing in the city treasury.

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
