

ORDINANCE No. 66-472

ORDINANCE

CREATING THE BARRIO OF LOYOLA HEIGHTS IN QUEZON CITY
AND DEFINING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF.

INTRODUCED BY COUNCILLER DIAMONON

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

Section 1. A barrio in Quezon City to be known as barrio "Loyola Heights" is hereby created with boundaries as follows:

Portion of the Diliman District and Quirino District, bounded on the NE by the Northern boundary line of Maryknoll Colleges; on the E by the boundary of Quezon City, on the S by the Southern Boundary line of M. L. Quezon property (Lot 7-6-1), on the SE by Jose P. Sargos Street, the Western boundary line of Good Shepherd Convent and eastern creek boundary of Project 3 and Project 2; and on the

NW by the NAWASA aqueduct. It comprises the following subdivisions and compounds:

- (1) Varsity Hills
- (2) Xavierville and the two (2) Magdalena Estate Subdivisions
- (3) E. Ramos Compound
- (4) Sta. Clara Monastery
- (5) Heirs of M. L. Quezon Compound
- (6) Ateneo de Manila Compound
- (7) Maryknoll Compound

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect on its approval:
