

ORDINANCE No. 60-4478

ORDINANCE
PROHIBITING THE BLOWING OF MOTOR CAR HORN, SIRENS, WHISTLES;
THE PLAYING OF LOUD MUSIC FROM RADIOS, JUKE BOXES, PUBLIC
ADDRESS SYSTEMS, PHONOGRAPHS AND OTHER MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS
AT THE VICINITY OF ANY HOSPITAL IN QUEZON CITY AND PROVIDING
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Introduced by the Committee on Public Safety

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

Section 1. The blowing of motor car horns, sirens, whistles; the playing of loud music, or speeches from radio receivers, juke boxes, public address systems, phonographs and other musical instruments at any time of day or night within a radius of Two Hundred (200) lineal meters from a hospital limit is hereby prohibited.

Sec. 2. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than five (P5.00) Pesos, nor more than twenty-five (P25.00) Pesos, or by imprisonment of not less than five (5) days, nor more than twenty-five (25) days or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

Sec. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect on its approval.
