## ORDINANCE

AMENDING SECTION 6, CHAPTER XLI OF ORDINANCE No. 2673, SERIES OF 1955, REGULATING THE CONDUCT AND OPERATION OF BUSINESSES AND OCCUPATION IN QUEZON CITY, AS THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE PROVISIONS IN QUEZON CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Introduced by the Committee on Public Safety

As it ordained by the Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

Section 1. Section 6, Chapter XLI of Ordinance

No. 2673, series of 1955, is hereby amended so as to add a sentence after the last sentence thereof, to read as follows:

"Provided, further, that any person employed as guard, watchman, police or detective by any agency, person, business firm, or corporation engaged in and in connection with its commercial, business or industrial undertaking shall be under the direct supervision of the Chief of Police while on duty and shall wear with his uniform an identifying uniform band with the inscription in bold letters "Special Police" or "Special Watchman," as the case may be, and the color of the same to be prescribed by the Chief of Police."

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect on its approval.
